Trustees reviewed the Utility Funds Report, Income Statement, and Balance Sheet for April 2023. Motion by Trustee Runneberg and seconded by Trustee Storms to authorize the Investment Committee to reinvest treasury 912828R69 upon maturity with the option to add an additional \$250,000 from operating funds. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Fiber-To-The-Premise Project Update: We will have all customers transitioned over to the new fiber system by the end of May. We will begin shutting down the old system in June.

Discussion was held on the Geotechnical Engineering Report on the proposed storage building site. Certified Testing Services, Inc. took 4 soil borings to explore the subsurface conditions of the site. The borings revealed various types of soil, including undocumented fill, fat clay, lean clay, sandy lean clay fill, glacial till, and weathered glacial till. Free water was encountered at depths ranging from 6.5 to 9 feet below the surface. This existing fill material is deemed unsuitable for the proposed building foundation and floor slabs.

CMBA Architects provided the following assumption: Six (6) foot of engineered fill will be required under the proposed building and 1.5" insulation will be needed under the concrete floor slab to minimize frost heave. Potential cost impact is \$35,000-\$65,000.

After a lengthy discussion, the Board asked the General Manager to visit with CMBA Architects about getting competitive quotes to repair the proposed building site right away so we can continue with the progress being made on preparing specifications and seeking out bids on the construction of the new storage building.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
